

Invitation to the general assembly and occupations of the Communication University

Dear friend,

As you may know, in the general assembly of the Communication University on 19th of November 2008, a wide group of students of our University decided to join the occupations movement of the different Catalan Universities.

The movement started last Monday, the 17th of November on the Politics and Sociology Universities of UAB, in order to defend an alternative education system: creating new places to discuss about the State University System that we want to afford. These occupations are being developed in a pacific way. They are being absolutely respectful with the infrastructures of the Campus University.

The main demands of the student movement are focused on these three points:

- 1.- Do a legal and useful referendum election voting for or against stopping the Bolonya's Plan process, based on the European harmony education, and the global discussion about that topic.
- 2.- To promote the cancellation of the academic recurs which have 31 students of UAB University, and to denied the 15 penal ascriptions.
- 3- The acclaimed of the shortfall budgetary that has Autonomia University of Barcelona, and to show an economy memory of the University costs.

The occupation of our university will be promoted next Wednesday, the 26th of November. We will follow the same way as the Politics and Sociology University do.

This movement responds to the missing information. We would like to expand our knowledge of Bolonia's Plan, because the government has not provided enough information.

Moreover, during the occupation we will deal with the main aspects of our degrees, Journalism, Audiovisual Communication and Publicity.

To sum up, the Communication Assembly University would like to invite you to join us the next Monday, the 24th of November at the hall of the university. You will be able to collaborate with us, to participate in all the activities that you want and to demonstrate for or against stopping Bolonia's Plan.
